Sealed bids will be received by the Hancock County Commissioners in the Office of the Hancock County Engineer, 1900 Lima Avenue, Findlay, OH 45840 until **10:30 A.M. February 1, 2024** for the contract cost to furnish to the Hancock County Engineer Maintenance Materials and Fuel.

Bids must be in accordance with specifications, detailed itemized lists of bid items and quantities to be furnished, and bidding documents that may be obtained at the Hancock County Engineers Office on January 11, 2024 or at the County Engineer's website. Bidders may bid on any complete item or items desired.

Bids will be received until the time and date stated above at the Office of the Hancock County Engineer. At which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read. Bids are to be sealed, marked "BID – ROAD MAINTENANCE MATERIALS AND FUEL 2024" and addressed to the Clerk of the Board of Commissioners.

The Hancock County Commissioners reserve the right to waive irregularities and to reject any or all bids submitted on any basis and without disclosure of a reason. The failure to make such a disclosure shall not result in the accrual of any right, claim, or cause of action by any successful bidder against Hancock County or the Board of County Commissioners.

Instructions to Bidders

Bids will be received until <u>10:30 a.m. local time on February 1, 2024</u> at the Office of the Hancock County Engineer. At which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read. Bids can be delivered to the Hancock County Engineer's Office:

Envelopes containing bids will be clearly marked as follows:

"BID – ROAD MAINTENANCE MATERIALS AND FUEL 2024"

Bids may be mailed, delivered by parcel delivery service, or hand delivered; but it remains the bidders' responsibility that bids are received in the Hancock County Engineer's Office before the deadline. Bids received after the deadline for any reason shall not be considered.

Bidders should carefully consider paragraph three (3) of the specifications. Award of a materials contract is intended by the Hancock County Engineer to provide an adequate and reliable source of specified materials for the time period specified in the Bid Proposal. Suppliers must also understand that variations and uncertainties in the annual work program make it impossible for the Hancock County Engineer to guarantee purchase of any minimum quantities of material. In submitting a bid suppliers acknowledge and agree to these conditions and waive any claim for anticipated profits.

Only complete the Bid Proposal Form and Required Forms for which Material you are bidding. Submit separate Bid Forms for different Quarries and / or different companies.

DO NOT MODIFY THE BID FORM IN ANY WAY. MODIFICATION OF THE BID FORM OR SUBSTITUTING ITEMS ON THE BID FORM WILL RESULT IN YOUR BID BEING DEEMED UNRESPONSIVE.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR MATERIALS

Materials shall meet the Standard Specifications of the State of Ohio Department of Transportation dated January 2023 or an equivalent material as listed in the most current revision, wherever applicable. Bidders shall list any exceptions to ODOT specifications or to these particular specifications.

All quantities are estimates and the bid is to furnish the quantities actually required as needed throughout the year.

The successful bidder for each item agrees to make every reasonable effort to maintain adequate stocks on hand sufficient to insure an uninterrupted supply for the Hancock County Engineer in accordance with the estimated quantities. The Engineer can provide on request information on seasonal variations in quantities used to assist the supplier in maintaining stock. Successful bidders agree that repeated shortages of items bid for whatever reason will be sufficient cause to allow the Hancock County Engineer at his option to cancel this award and/or purchase remaining material quantities from the next best alternate sources. The Hancock County Engineer makes no guarantee as to the minimum quantities to be purchased, and all bidders by submitting a bid acknowledge and agree to these conditions and waive any claim for anticipated profits.

Successful bidders are <u>required</u> to furnish for our files all current Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for all materials furnished under this bid wherever applicable. Materials will not be accepted for delivery without all applicable MSDS information.

Bid price shall include all applicable taxes, fuel surcharge fees and other fees. No additional compensation above the bid price shall not be permitted. The award for all materials with estimated quantities will remain in effect for the period stated in the Bid Proposal. Invoices must be submitted to the Hancock County Engineer's Office. Payment will be made through the Hancock County Auditor's Office in accordance with standard payment procedures of the Auditor and Hancock County.

QUESTIONS ABOUT THE TERMS OF THE PROPOSAL

All Questions shall be submitted <u>in writing</u> to the Hancock County Engineer via mail or email up to 5 business days prior to the Bid Opening to Hancock County Engineer Douglas E. Cade, PE, PS. Questions submitted after that deadline cannot be answered. No other persons are authorized to answer any questions concerning bid documents.

However, the bid documents as written will still govern in all cases and no interpretation, if offered, will serve to change the written terms of the bid.

If errors or ambiguities or other conditions are disclosed that warrant changes or clarifications to the bid documents, all such changes will be made only by a written addendum transmitted to all holders of bidding documents receipt of which must be acknowledged with the bid. Where appropriate, the bid opening date may also be extended as part of any addendum in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code.
