

## Minutes

November 22, 2022

Commissioners present: Michael Pepple and William Bateson. Timothy Bechtol absent.

Also Present: Alec Helms, Cindy Land, Charity Rauschenberg, Adam Witteman and David Devore.

Commissioner Pepple opened the meeting at 9:30 a.m. in the Commissioner's 1st floor conference room. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes from the November 17, 2022 meeting was read with William Bateson making a motion to approve, Michael Pepple seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

William Bateson made a motion to approve the Warrant Journal and Michael Pepple seconded. Motion passed 2-0. The Commissioners approved an invoice from ACI Construction, Co. and a travel request for the Sheriff.

Cindy Land presented the following resolution:

Resolution #812-22 – Universal extension of the contract between the Board of Hancock County Commissioners and AT & T ILEC for Centrex Services. Cindy Land stated we must have a few Centrex landlines that come into the dispatch center for back up in case of emergency. This is to extend the contract with AT & T for another year for that service. William Bateson made a motion to approve, Michael Pepple seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Cindy Land presented the following resolution for Phil Johnson:

Resolution #813-22 – Authorizing a second solicitation of bids for provision of snow removal services for properties owned by the Board of Hancock County Commissioners on County Road 140 in Hancock County, for the 2022-2023 Winter Season. Cindy Land stated it was her understanding that this was put out for bid and no bids were received. Since then Mike Thompson has received word from a few companies that they were unaware of the bid but would like the information if it is rebid. Mike will send the information to the interested parties once this resolution is passed. William Bateson made a motion to approve, Michael Pepple seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Auditor Charity Rauschenberg stated that the fiscal office is getting ready for dog tag season. That will begin on December 1<sup>st</sup>. The online system has been working great. There was a discussion on the debt information that was provided during the CAC meeting about possible spring borrowing and the options available if borrowing to pay for a new jail is needed. Charity stated that the new values have been approved by the Department of Taxation. There was a discussion on the county's credit rating which is currently an Aa2.

Adam Witteman brought up the possibility of amending resolution #805-22. He stated this should come out of the Insurance line not Contingencies. Auditor Rauschenberg agreed. William Bateson made a motion to amend resolution #805-22 and Michael Pepple seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

### Meetings/Reports

Timothy Bechtol was absent.

William Bateson attended the Parks and Recreation planning meeting yesterday. They presented the plans for Civitan Park in phase 2 of the benching project.

Michael Pepple had nothing to report.

At 10:00 a.m., the Commissioners met with Don Moses from the Landfill. Also present was Alec Helms and David Devore. Don Moses stated he felt there was some questions about the overtime being worked at the Landfill. There is no way to avoid the over time. Half of the guys will get 5 hours of overtime each week. This will be anyone working on Saturdays. He has tried to back the guys off or stagger but he is just not able to. They are still very busy and he has a great group of guys working for him out there. They have changed their hours back to 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. during the week and 7:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. on Saturdays. This means the guys work 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. during the week so anyone who works Saturday will automatically be in overtime. There was a discussion on the holiday hours for the Landfill. Don stated their compactor is having transmission issues. They will be having Ohio Cat fix it. This will take about 2 months and the estimated cost is \$79,174.40. The Horizontal Piping system installation should be done tomorrow. The contractor has been great to work with.

At 10:15 a.m. the Commissioners met with Sheriff Heldman. Also present was Alec Helms, Ryan Kidwell and David Devore. Sheriff Heldman stated the current door control and intercom system was last updated in 2008 and has reached the end of its mechanical life. There is currently being a grant program put together. They are making \$50 million available for county jail upgrades. We could apply for some of the money and the county would be responsible for 20% of the cost of the project. Ryan Kidwell explained the program and the intent on how to disburse the money. The preliminary cost estimate for replacing the who system would be \$310,600.00 which would mean the county contribution would be \$62,120.00. Commissioner Bateson stated this seems worth applying for the money to see if we are able to get it. Commissioner Pepple agreed. Ryan stated he will get all of the application stuff completed and brought to the Commissioners next week for signatures. He also went over the requirements for submitting the application.
