REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS FOR SERVICES

The Hancock County Commissioners intends to contract for Construction Materials Testing and Special Inspection services in connection with the new Hancock County Judicial Center project in the City of Findlay, Ohio. Engineering Consulting firms interested in being considered for a contract to provide the required services should reply with a Statement of Qualifications no later than 1:00 pm on May 25, 2023. Statements received after this deadline will not be considered.

Statements of Qualifications should include information regarding: the firm's history, education and experience of owners and key technical personnel, technical expertise of the firm's current staff, the firm's experience with similar projects, availability of staff, the firm's equipment and facilities, list of laboratory certifications, a summary of construction materials testing and special inspection services offered, a project approach, references, and any previous work performed for the Hancock County Commissioners.

As required by Ohio Revised Code § 153.65-71, responding firms will be evaluated and ranked in order of their qualifications. Following this evaluation, the County will enter into contract negotiations with the most highly qualified firm.

NAME OF PROJECT:	Hancock County Judicial Center
LOCATION:	209 W. Main Cross Street, Findlay, Ohio 45840
DESCRIPTION:	Includes construction material testing and special inspection services for a new ground up judicial building for the Hancock County Commissioners. The building is three stories above grade plus a mechanical Penthouse for a total of 47,153 sf. The project also includes asphalt parking areas and public sidewalks.
TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET:	The project is currently budgeted around \$21,900,000.00
